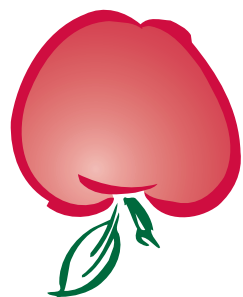

Grilled Fresh Veggies

For marinade, whisk together 1/4 cup olive oil, 2T red wine vinegar, 2T fresh thyme, 1/2 t salt, 1/4 t coarse black pepper and 1 clove minced garlic.

Pour over an assortment of fresh Michigan veggies cut into chunks (asparagus, par-boiled new potatoes, zucchini, yellow squash, mushrooms, and red and green peppers). Marinate for 30 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Position grill basket on grate directly over medium hot coals. Remove veggies from marinade and stir-fry approximately 5 to 7 minutes until crisp and tender.

Serve immediately.

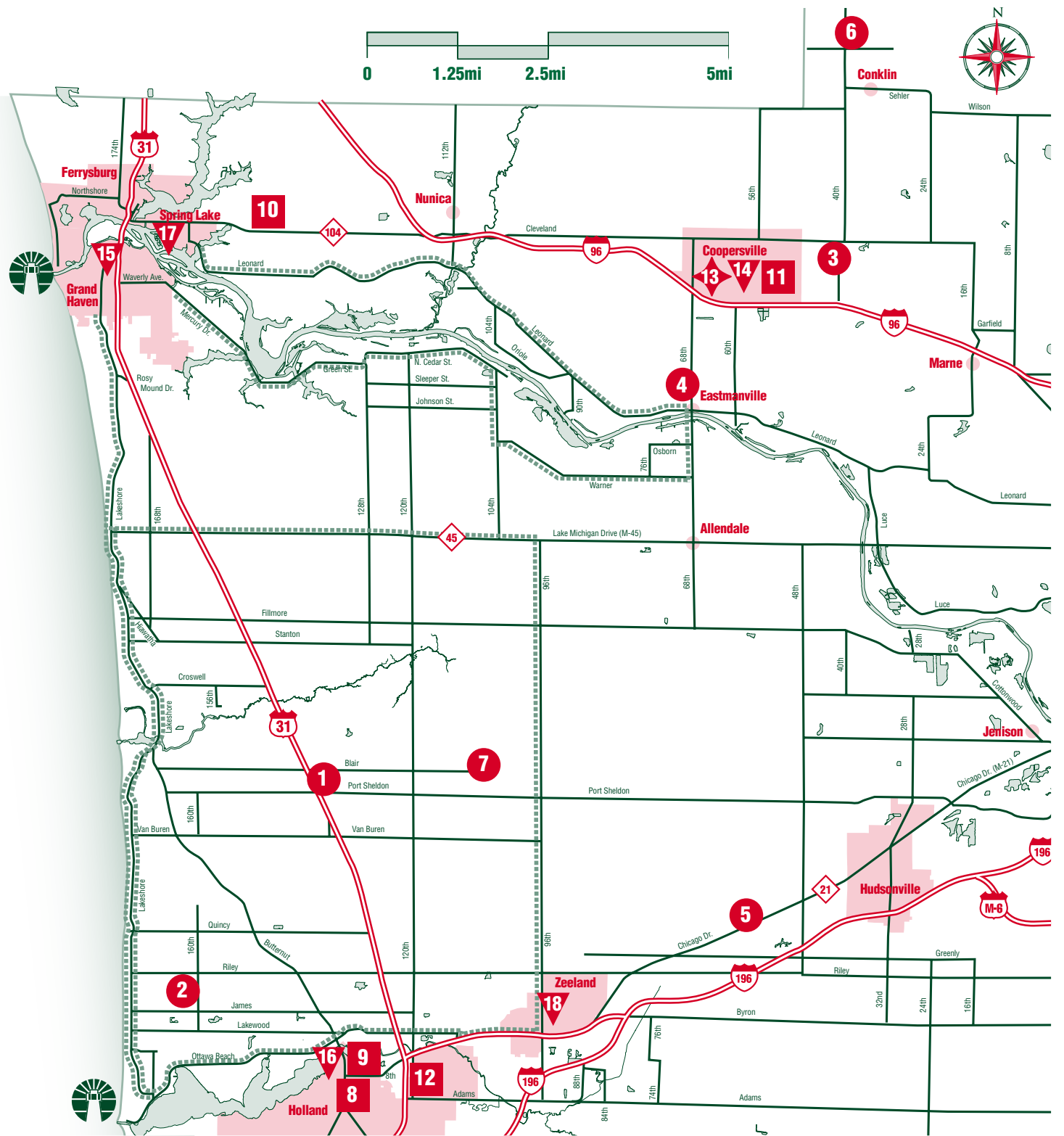
